The Lesson Readiness program for children ages three to five is thoughtfully designed to provide young students with a joyful, structured, and developmentally appropriate introduction to music. Because these early years are foundational, consistency, preparation, and committed instruction are essential to the success of each child enrolled.

To ensure the highest level of educational continuity and to reserve a dedicated space in this limited-enrollment class, a **monthly deposit is required**. This deposit secures your child's place in the program and reflects a shared commitment between the family and the instructor to honor scheduled instructional time.

From an educational standpoint, consistent attendance is critical at this age. Young children thrive on routine, familiarity, and repetition. When lessons are missed or attendance is inconsistent, progress is disrupted and the carefully sequenced curriculum loses its effectiveness. A secured enrollment allows the instructor to plan intentionally for each student, tailoring activities that support musical growth, motor development, listening skills, and confidence.

From a professional standpoint, the deposit policy also addresses the reality of no-shows and last-minute cancellations, which result in lost instructional time and income that cannot be recovered. By securing enrollment in advance, this policy allows the instructor to fully dedicate time, energy, and preparation to each student without the uncertainty that undermines the quality of instruction.

His ability to engage young children with warmth, clarity, patience, and structure sets him apart.
